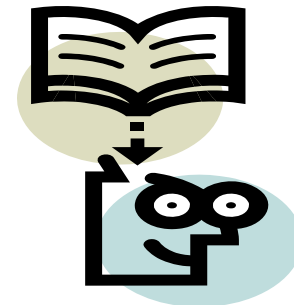


Parent Tips
