SIGN-IN/OUT

PROCEDURE

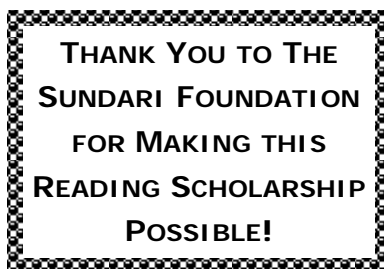
RAPIDS WATER PARK
